The Student Monies Allocation Committee met on Tuesday, January 28, 2020 at 11:00 a.m. in the Student Affairs Conference Room of the Roaden University Center.

**Model UN of TTU**

The organization requested \$3,286.27 for hotel, registration, and travel expenses to attend the Model United Nations Conference in Charlotte, NC. A motion was made by Jackson Lelle and seconded by Ryan Griffeth to approve \$2,168.94 for hotel, registration, and travel expenses. The motion carried. After the meeting it was brought to Student Affairs attention that the organization was requesting 66% of the total funds needed for their trip. Considering that information, an email was sent out to the committee members asking them to vote on increasing the awarded amount to \$3,286.27 or proceeding with the initial amount awarded. After receiving replies the majority voted to increase the amount to \$3,286.27.

**ELSO**

The organization requested \$9,478.92 for hotel, registration, and travel expenses to multiple conferences for the Spring 2020 semester. A motion was made by Ryan Griffeth and seconded by Brad Sells to approve \$5,070.04 for hotel, travel, and registration expenses. The motion carried.

The organization requested \$2,759.40 for travel and hotel expenses to attend the National Student Nurses' Association Convention in Orlando, FL. A motion was made by Ryan Griffeth and seconded by Jackson Lelle to approve \$2,759.40 for travel and hotel expenses. The motion carried.

**Formula SAE**

The organization requested \$6,617.14 for travel and hotel expenses to compete in the Spring 2020 Formula SAE competition. A motion was made by Jackson Lelle and

seconded by Ryan Griffeth to approve \$4,817.14 for travel and hotel expenses. The motion carried.

**Graduate Chemistry Club**

The organization requested \$5,096.72 for hotel, travel, and registration expenses to attend the National Meeting of the American Chemical Society in Philadelphia, PA. A motion was made by Brad Sells and seconded by Ryan Griffeth to approve \$5,070.04 for hotel, travel, and registration expenses. The motion carried.

A motion was made by Brady Hancock and seconded by Ryan Griffeth to approve \$5,070.04 for hotel, travel, and registration expenses. The motion carried.
