

# Whitson-Hester School of Nursing

## TENNESSEE TECH

Tennessee Tech's Whitson-Hester School of Nursing offers an online RN-to-BSN Program that can be completed in as little as three semesters.

### **RN-BSN COURSES:**

30 hours of online Nursing credit must be completed through TNTech. Courses are offered on a rotation that means that students can finish their RN-BSN requirements in three back-to-back semesters.

### **ASSOCIATE PROGRAM CREDITS:**

Up to 32 hours of Nursing credit can be transferred from your Associates in Nursing program. These 32 hours are listed in GOLD on the Program Curriculum.

### **GEN ED COURSES**:

58 hours of general education course are required. Students can complete these courses at TTU or transfer credits in from other institutions to fulfill these requirements. Most ASN programs include courses that will satisfy many of these general education requirements. These courses are listed in **PURPLE** on the program curriculum.

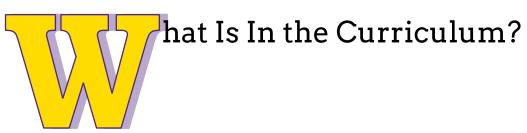
**30 total Nursing credit hours must be completed online through TNTech in order to complete BSN degree requirements.** Additionally, the last 12 credit hours used for degree requirements must be completed at TNTech—any general education requirements remaining after getting down to the last 12 hours could no longer be completed somewhere else. Otherwise students can take General Education courses and Nursing courses concurrently and can mix online enrollment at TNTech with online or on-ground enrollment at other institutions.

Students should email an unofficial copy of their transcripts to **Jamie Gunter** at <a href="mailto:jrgunter@tntech.edu">jrgunter@tntech.edu</a> to see which general education courses may transfer to TNTech to fulfill requirements for the RN-BSN Curriculum.

Students can start the RN-BSN program for Fall, Spring, or Summer semester. **We do ask that students apply one to two months prior to the semester they intend to begin.** Keep in mind that you must apply to the university itself before applying to the Nursing program.
