

The Henry Dreyfus Teacher-Scholar Awards Program is open to academic institutions in the States, Districts, and Territories of the United States of America that grant a bachelor's or master's degree in the chemical sciences, including biochemistry, materials chemistry, and chemical engineering. Awardees are typically in departments that do not grant a doctoral degree. **A potential nominee is ineligible if there is active participation or substantial research productivity in a Ph.D. program of another department or in an interdisciplinary Ph.D. program.**

Nominees must hold a full-time tenure-track academic appointment, be after the fourth and not after the twelfth years of their independent academic careers, **and be engaged in research and teaching primarily with undergraduates.**

TTU is permitted to submit only **one (1)** nomination annually which makes necessary an internal review to select the nomination that will be submitted.

The following items must be submitted to the Office of Research email account (research@tntech.edu) as a single pdf by **noon, Friday, June 19.**

- a **summary description** of the nominee's research accomplishments as an independent faculty member and a description of research plans (limited to six pages including references),
- a **statement** that illustrates the nominee's efforts in education in the chemical sciences (limited to two pages), and
- a **CV** (limited to five pages) including a list of publications in which independent contributions and undergraduate and graduate student coauthors are clearly and separately identified. Research support should be indicated.

These documents will be reviewed by internal reviewers. Note these documents are just part of the full Henry Dreyfus nomination package. Information regarding the full nomination procedure should be reviewed on the [Dreyfus Foundation website](#).

Internal dates for the Henry Dreyfus Teacher-Scholar Awards Program are provided below.

- **Noon, Friday, June 19, 2020:** Deadline to submit **summary description, education statement, and CV** to the Office of Research (as a single PDF emailed to research@tntech.edu)
- June 22-26, 2020: Internal Review conducted
- June 29, 2020: Selected nominee will be notified. Nominee will need to finalize their summary description and prepare the other required elements of the nomination package including a letter of nomination from their chair or dean and one page budget. Note that three letters of support are required to be submitted separately from the nomination package. Visit the link above for full details.

- July 31, 2020: Receipt of all final documents for nomination package and signed Proposal Endorsement Form (PEF) in the Office of Research
- August 6, 2020: Tennessee Tech will submit one nomination package as a PDF to programs@dreyfus.org.
