

**An Act to Improve Restroom Wheelchair Accessibility**

- Whereas,** in order for some wheelchair users to be able to use the restroom, a lift and care system is necessary, and,
- Whereas,** Tennessee Tech has only one unisex, wheelchair accessible restroom with a lift and care system, and,
- Whereas,** certain wheelchair users are limited to a sole restroom to which they can utilize on the north side of campus, and,
- Whereas,** some wheelchair users are unable to use the ADA compliant restrooms, making it unsafe and ineffective, and,

**NOW THEREFORE,**

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE STUDENT GOVERNMENT ASSOCIATION OF  
TENNESSEE TECHNOLOGICAL UNIVERSITY THAT**

- Section 1:** This bill shall be known as the "Wheelchair Accessible Restrooms with Lift System Act of 2020"
- Section 2:** A "Sure Hands Lift and Care System" will be installed in the unisex restroom, located in Kittrell Hall.
- Section 3:** A Contour, Standard Sling, comprised of padded legs, 4 straps, and mesh fabric, will be installed in this restroom.
- Section 4:** A Wall Lift System (6 Cycle, Plug-In), which includes a Wall Plate & Pneumatic Hand Control, will be installed in this restroom.
- Section 5:** A Standing Support for the Wall Lift system will be installed in this restroom.
- Section 6:** An Extension for the Wall Lift will be installed in this restroom.
- Section 7:** A Standard Spreader Bar with Attached Side Bars will be installed in this restroom.
- Section 8:** This Bill shall take effect immediately upon passage by the Student Government Association, the welfare of the students requiring it.


