# SGA Resolution SR-F22-R005 A Resolution to Increase the Amount of Bike Racks in Heavily Trafficked Areas on Campus

Whereas, bicycle travel is a fantastic way to promote personal well-being and

environmental conservation as opposed to vehicular travel; and,

Whereas, many Tech students use bikes to navigate campus; and,

Whereas, bike racks are necessary to ensure the security of personal bikes; and,
