NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT ENACTED BY THE STUDENT GOVERNMENT ASSOCIATION OF TENNESSEE TECHNOLOGICAL UNIVERSITY THAT

Section 1: This bill shall be known as the "Addition of the Pharmabox in the New,Lab

Science Building Act of 2021."

Section 2: The Pharmabox will be placed on the first floor of the New Lab Science Building.

Section 3: The merchandise within the vending machine will be chosen by Health Services.

Section 4: Tennessee Tech will receive revenue from the sales of the box.

Section 5: This Bill shall take effect immediately upon passage by the Student Government

Association, the welfare of the students requiring it.
