## A Resolution to Add a Crosswalk to North Willow Avenue

Whereas, Many Tennessee Tech students who live on or near North Willow Avenue at

Tech Village and surrounding off-campus apartments located between 7th Street

and 12th Street often walk to campus and,

Whereas, Many Tennessee Tech students illegally cross North Willow Avenue from Tech

Village and the surrounding apartment complexes and,

Whereas, The nearest crosswalk is located at Tech Village, but does not have any traffic

lights, and,

Whereas, The nearest crosswalk with traffic lights is located at the intersection of North

Willow Ave. and University Dr., and,

Whereas, It is necessary for the safety of students, that a crosswalk be put in place near

their common path of travel which is at the 7th Street, 8th Street, and 9th Street

locations, and,

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED, on this 29<sup>th</sup> day of March 2021, the Student Government Association requests a crosswalk be added to the intersection of North Willow Avenue and West 9<sup>th</sup> Street. In addition to the crosswalk addition, we request that traffic control lights also be added to make the intersection safer for students to cross. If a crosswalk is unable to be installed at the intersection of North Willow Avenue and West 9th Street, we request one be installed at the intersection of North Willow Avenue and West 7th Street, where a traffic control light system is already in place. The crosswalk should include curb ramps, pavement markings, and any other ADA recommendations for crosswalks.
