Section 1: This bill shall be known as the "SGA By-laws Recompilation Act of 2022".

Section 2: The Constitutional Reform Committee of the SGA Senate will review and revise

the grammar and formatting of the SGA By-laws.

The Constitutional Reform Committee of the SGA Senate will submit the revised Section 3:

By-laws to the Senate no later than March 21st, 2022
